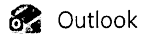

MART Action Plan

Asthma Maintenance and Reliever Therapy (MART) - Luforbec can be used for Maintenance And Reliever Therapy (sometimes referred to as MART). This means that it can be used to maintain your asthma control but also to relieve sudden symptoms you may experience between your usual doses. Previously you may have used a blue (reliever) inhaler for this. You can now use Luforbec for these sudden symptoms should they occur, which is why it is very important to keep your inhaler with you at all times.

Green - My asthma is under control

My regular maintenance dosing is:

2 puffs of Luforbec daily

You should also use your Luforbec device as a reliever inhaler to treat sudden asthma symptoms, so please ensure you keep it with you at all times.

For Asthma Symptom Relief - If you get sudden asthma symptoms:

2 puffs of Luforbec daily

You should not take more than 6 reliever puffs in one day

2 puffs of Luforbec daily

Maintenance puffs Maximum reliever puffs Maximum total puffs

My asthma is well controlled when:

- I am not woken at night by coughing, breathlessness, wheezing or chest tightness
- I have no symptoms during the day (such as coughing, wheezing, breathlessness or tight chest)
- My asthma hasn't interfered with normal daily activities

If my symptoms change or increase, or I am using my reliever more than I should, I need to review the 'Yellow' section of my MART action plan

Yellow - My asthma is not under control

If, over a period of 2-3 days...

My asthma symptoms are getting worse (I feel more breathless, cough more, wheeze more, have a tight chest, am sleeping poorly, or my symptoms are interfering with my daily activities)

Or if...

- I am using more than 2 puffs of Luforbec per day (I should not use more than 8 puffs in total in any one day)

Patients requiring frequent use of rescue inhalations daily should be strongly recommended to seek medical advice.

NEED TO continue to use Luforbec daily as per my action plan PLUS any additional reliever treatment I've been prescribed, as needed

AND

Contact my doctor, nurse or other healthcare professional The sooner I can treat my increasing symptoms, the sooner I can lower my risk of an asthma attack.

- To lower my risk, I should ask the receptionist for an URGENT SAME DAY APPOINTMENT, tell them my asthma is getting worse, and that I need to see someone for urgent advice
- If I cannot get an appointment, or my GP is closed, I should call 111 for advice

Other instructions:

Red - My asthma is severe

The signs of an asthma attack are:

My symptoms continue to get worse, even after I've used my reliever puffs

- I am coughing/wheezing a lot, or have a very tight chest
- My breathing is getting faster and it feels like I can't get my breath in properly
- I am breathless and find it difficult to walk and talk

If I have the signs of an asthma attack I MUST:

- Sit up straight (don't lie down) and use my Luforbec inhaler immediately
- Loosen tight clothing
- Try to take slow, steady breaths and remain calm

If there is no immediate improvement:

- Take 1 additional puff as needed in response to symptoms. If symptoms persist after a few minutes, an additional puff should be taken, up to a maximum of 6 puffs no more than 8 puffs in total should be taken per day.

If I do not feel better after taking my Luforbec device as instructed above I MUST call 999 or a doctor urgently

Even if my symptoms improve and I do not need to call 999, I should still make an urgent appointment with my GP or nurse within 24 hours. I should also continue to take my medication as per my action plan and make sure I have time to rest and recover
