This is just to let you know that the above infant who was admitted as a possible case of gastro-enteritis to King's Cross Hospital on 15th August was transferred on the same day to Ward 29 at Ninewells Hospital. It was felt that the child probably had acute meningitis and in view of his very young age and the degree of his illness it was thought best to transfer him where he would be nearer to an intensive care unit. I gather that the child did indeed have pyogenic meningitis and that scanty meningococci have been seen in the CSF. You will be hearing of his further progress from Ninewells, the child's step brother was yesterday admitted to King's Cross Hospital with a two days history of headache, there is however no evidence that he does indeed have a meningial infection and he is being kept under observation here meantime.

I saw William who was accompanied by his foster father at the Centre for Child Health on 31st May 2001. As yet my assessment is incomplete and I am awaiting some school reports. I will be writing to you in more detail in the near future.

However, in brief, William presented as a boy with a history of repeated movements for more than a year, mainly clicking of his fingers and he was observed to be rocking continually. However, he does not seem to be displaying any phonic tics and therefore at present does not fulfil the criteria for Tourette's Syndrome but would probably fulfil the criteria for Chronic Tic Disorder or stereotypic behaviour.

However, William is showing no distress because of his movements and there is no obvious impairment due to this. He has settled well in his primary school where he has been for the last 5 months as well as with his foster family.

We had a brief discussion about Tic Disorder/Tourette's Disorder and possible treatments but at present will not be instigating any specific treatment. I have not given a further appointment as yet and will await the school report and if there is any cause for concern in that, I will issue them with another appointment in August/September.

William was accompanied by his current carer, Mrs Hazel Lunan. He is in Primary 3 at Longhaugh Primary School and struggles with academic work, receiving learning support on most days, particularly in relation to reading.

He is noted to have a very short attention span, quickly losing interest in any activity, including TV programmes and the Megadrive (computer games).

He enjoys boisterous outdoor play and football. Indoors he likes to play with his action man.

In school he enjoys number work, finding it "easy", but finds spelling the most difficult.

He sleeps well, if lightly, and settles to sleep quickly.

Thank you for coming along for the useful case discussion that we had this morning. William is a boy who has longstanding difficulties which we are well aware of. One of the most concerning things currently however, is William's erotically charged behaviour. As you know Michael and William had a relationship which it turns out was a sexual nature and this leads us to question what their early life experience was of sexual acts.

William presents in having difficulty in forming appropriate relationships at an emotional level with adults and at times other children, and will revert to behaviour which he has known and understood in the past.

If we are to institute any change in William, he needs to learn other ways of interacting and to receive appropriate gratification from this.

His foster carer currently is providing a very high degree of structure and supervision which William currently needs. As he discussed though, she does at times wonder if she's providing enough for him, and I think become overwhelmed by the fear that William may go on to be an offender in the future.

There is no doubt that this boys behaviour is concerning and needs to be addressed. In the first instance, I feel it is appropriate to work with the foster carer to try and alter this behaviour and to try and provide William with more experience of appropriate interactions on an emotional level.



I would suggest that we provide this structure in the first instance and review the use William has made of this and his ability to learn from it in six months time.

We will meet again in August as discussed, to review current progress.

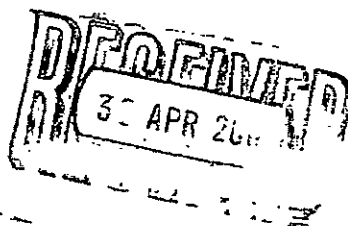
