Unfortunately, many years ago, there was a serious fire at the venue where all information relating to Bellevue was destroyed.

Two (2) small notebooks were recovered extremely water damaged. These contained the names of children who were baptised or made their 1st Holy Communion up to 1958. I have checked the names and sadly your client does not appear.
