<u>Late Entry</u> 21.1.99	Spoke with Lewis over at P.E. to inform him of possible home visit, he seemed happy enough with this.
<u>25.1.99</u>	plc, to Mr Cameron to inform him of home visit this week possibly Thursday evening.
<u>28.1.99</u>	<p>Family meeting; both dad and Lewis were present in what turned out to be a very comfortable and productive meeting. John Cameron was able to raise his concerns about Lewis attending Kibble & the Ext Day place saying L. would be spending more time on the evenings & weekends than he does already. Confirmed that it would only be 1 evening and 1 on 2 Sats. Also individual work until an appropriate group work placement is found with fortnightly family meetings (Thurs). Lewis has contact with mum although this is very limited. John felt the SW had placed pressure on L. to keep contact with mum using Kibble & dad's overnights as sanctions. He is concerned that although he has Lewis 6 nights going to 7 a week he does not have legal rights to documents minutes of meetings and DSS benefits. He will be looking for financial assistance and has spoken to SW re this.</p> <p>They had moved into a new flat and were very keen to show me around. Lewis was v. relaxed and friendly he gave me a guided tour of house, his Toys, his room etc. He is keen to take part in the outside activities particularly camping abserling. Spoke sometime about Inverness They</p>

moved down in 1995. Lewis was involved in all outdoor activities and the move to Troon was a culture shock. He has limited friends being at school in Kibble does not help this dad stated although Lewis definitely does not want to attend mainstream. He prefers smaller classes and the varied curriculum at K. His ed. report was apparently excellent and the Ed Psychologist, stated there was no reason he should not return to mainstream.

She will contact Bob Jess (resource manager) to confirm and call us back p/c from Linda Cunny she will call Alan Beattie re funding.
23.2.99	p/c to Alan Beattie re funding he is going to raise this at the resource meeting in two weeks and try to get Ed. to pay for his Taxi. Lewis involved in a fight with [redacted]. It appears [redacted] stole his hat then threw it away when Lewis got it back [redacted] jumped on his back the two started to punch each other before a member of staff broke it up. 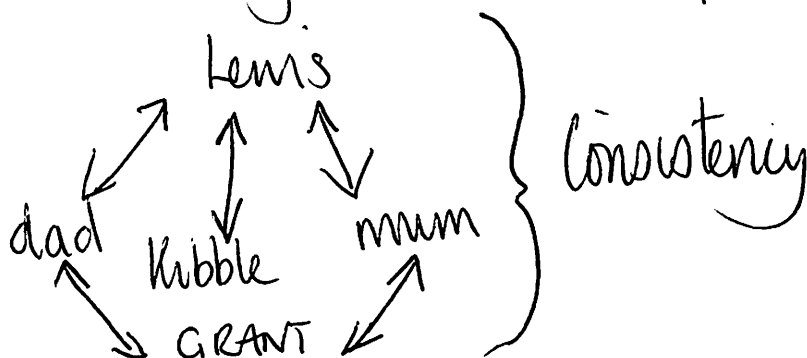
