28/6/99	P/c from John. Lewis did not get up for school this morning. His weekend was good Saturday with Lewis being very sociable & co-operative however refused to go to Irvine with Dad on Sunday saying he wanted to stay with the friends he had made in Troon & refusing to budge. John feeling quite frustrated with the situation. Arranged to meet with John & Lewis at home tomorrow. P/c to Linda Currie to inform of situation, message left as she was not answering.
29/6/99	Visited both Lewis & dad at home this morning. They had a run in with each other last night. Lewis returned 2 hours late without phone calls etc. & wished to go back out after 10 mins. John ended up restraining Lewis in the hall as it had escalated out of proportion. Lewis also cut his hand deliberately over an old scar. Covered some issues regarding responsibilities at home, anger dissipation and concerns of self-harm. Outlined some areas of work for over the summer period with both Lewis & John. Lewis may turn up for school tomorrow as it is the last day. A good visit this morning, lasted 1 1/2 hrs. <u>Anita</u> .
2/7/99	P/c to Linda Curry (S.W.) re: police checks. Again not available but clear message left for her to phone us back as soon as possible. (1.30pm). <u>Anita</u> .

13-7-99	<p>Spoke with John on the phone. Lewis was unsettled over the weekend as he was not allowed to camp out on Friday night. This was due to his friend [REDACTED] telling John a girl was supposed to rendezvous with them that night & so he did not wish to camp out - Lewis did not know [REDACTED] had said anything. Lewis took the huff & sat out the back at the hut before using a piece of wood to bang off railings. After some coaxing he went into the house and into his room where he eventually started hitting the wood off his drawers. He refused to calm down & ended up being restrained by John in his room. Again he refused to calm down & when John let him up he left the house. John phoned the school for some support & Lewis returned during the call which escalated his behaviour again & again he left the house. He returned after 10mins. somewhat calmer & John decided to try & pick it up the next day which he did to resolution.</p> <p>On Sunday Lewis had said he would go through to Irvine with John when he was going to work however he didn't get up when called & John had to go. He left money for Lewis to get the bus but Lewis phoned him at work & was verbal to him on the phone. Again John went home at lunch time to try & resolve the issue & Lewis did take on some responsibility for his actions but also tried to shrug the majority of it.</p>

14/7/99	<p>Home visit with John & Lewis at 1230-1420hr. Apart from the incident at the weekend everything has been great. Lewis making good friends in an appropriate peer group. Spoke about his anger management & the plan developed is for Lewis to take time out (go for a walk) to calm down. When John notices his behaviour escalating he will prompt Lewis as a reminder of his plan. Both in agreement to try this plan. Lewis very unhappy with mum however as she will not give him his £30 (own money) to go to Ireland & he feels she is trying to stop his contact with his relatives over there. Communication has broken down between Lewis & mum & is mainly unhelpful between John & mum. This will require some work.</p> <p style="text-align: right;">Anita.</p>

15/7/99 Lewis picked up at home by Taxi & was in school for 8.55am. Attended for groupwork, climbing Ben 'An with David, [REDACTED] He seemed very relaxed according to David and had an excellent day. On the way back down he built a shelter using logs, sticks & moss etc. All well with Lewis.

4/8	<p>Lewis came on camp. He was well prepared & had brought his fishing gear with him which he was very generous in sharing with the other boys. Lewis had an excellent time and was very good company participating in all activities on offer. Some of the boys took advantage of Lewis' good nature and were not respectful of him. Lewis started to stand up for himself in the latter stages of camp withdrawing certain equipment from the group if he felt he was being treated unfairly by them. Paul Stewart reported seeing Lewis, [REDACTED] & [REDACTED] walking along the Dual Carriageway towards Kibble just in time to get their taxi home. (We did not receive this information until the following afternoon from Jean Logan).</p>
14/9.	<p>Lewis out of school again this morning with [REDACTED]. They were R.T.S. over lunchtime by the police & Lewis was cautioned for possession of Cannabis pending a charge if the substance is formally identified. Again Lewis was unsettled in the afternoon refusing to go into classes and taking no responsibility for any of the days events. When asked about the Cannabis he said he forgot he had it in his pocket and was not particularly interested in the school not rules, his responsibility or the consequences. Spoke to John at length re: these incidents on the phone & suggested he spend time with Lewis, to try & find out if there are any other issues for him, before his review at 3pm tomorrow.</p>
