15-3-99	Tlc to Dad's Mum's mobile - left message. sb
"	Tlc from Mum. Discussed events of the weekend. Lewis had called mum at 8pm on Saturday to ask if dad could drop himself + Grant off at 7.30am on Sunday as Dad was working. Carrie explained she initially agreed but then after hanging up she felt angry as Dad should not ask her to care for Lewis when he is working. She called John back to say she was unhappy - John hung up - Carrie states she had been angry. She called back again + left an angry message in the answering machine. Grant would normally be returned home about lunchtime. Came making the point dad should arrange appropriate child care when he is working. John brought Grant home at approx. 9am on Sunday. Came also expressed concern about the amount of time (allegedly) [redacted] (Lewis's friend) spends at John's house.

15-3-99	<p>Met with Lewis. Initially reluctant to talk - saying it was "all sorted" - but then opened up a bit.</p> <p>- 'I'm not feeling well but dad sent me to school' - he did have a chesty cough.</p> <p>Lewis confirmed he called his mum on Saturday (he said this was his idea). He was aware of the subsequent argument between mum + dad - Dad has kept the tape from the answering machine for future evidence?</p> <p>Lewis agreed it was too early to get up on Sunday but also said he was not keen to go to mums (usual reasons). He informed he was very angry when he trashed his room but could not say with whom.</p> <p>Lewis informed the taxi was dropping him at Dad's work in Crine tonight as Dad is working until 6.00pm. [need to confirm ex with SW]</p>

<u>19/4/99</u>	<p>Plc from Lewis' Dad to say he has the chance of a 3 day holiday on the 20/5/99 he planned to confirm this is ok. We said yes. He will confirm this is ok with PSH. Unfortunately another call came through so I did not get a chance to ask how the weekend was.</p>
<u>20/4/99</u>	<p>(with S.S.) Lewis out of class some period 7, wanting to play chess. It was not possible to catch him. I have left word I expect him to be on payback on Friday. David spent sometime with Lewis at the end of the day but Lewis was very reluctant to share feelings & thoughts. The outcome was pretty poor and it was left to pick up following day. Plc to dad before Lewis arrived home gave him an update and he asked for advice on how best to handle the situ. I gave him some pointers and would phone back. Dad showed some commitment to come into school in the morning to be involved in the discussion.</p>
<u>21-4-99</u>	<p>Writer spent some time discussing yesterday's antics and the underpinning feelings he has in relation to this. He was reluctant to divulge any indepth feelings although he recognised that things had changed for him at school and at home. He indicated that he was unhappy at home through boredom. He returned to class but I later got a call from Pat Young to inform us that he had been refusing to do his work. She commented that he is struggling to do his reading & writing work and suggested "paired reading" at home.</p>

Date

22.4.99.

Summary of Contact

Reasonable day for Lewis in school. However, he was extremely reluctant to attend the group and had to be encouraged to move away from his taxi and come into unit. He resorted to foul language and mumbling under his breath about running away from unit.

He had tea but completely refused to speak with worker about how he was feeling and why he wanted to go home.

He (a short while after) left the unit and proceeded to walk towards the whole in the fence. He refused to return voluntarily and was eventually returned by staff.

He became v. angry and volatile and was consequently held in a TC1 restraint for a short time till he calmed down.

This created an opportunity for writer & D Barr to discuss current events with Lewis. We looked at

school-bullying possibility / self-harm. He accepted that he hurt himself when he was angry (with himself).

Although he did not go into anything in great detail it was clear that he was upset angry and unsure of how to communicate this other than acting out & self harm.

Internalizing these feelings was highlighted not to be in his best interests.

He did not want to visit mum as he seemed angry at her for an accident at weekend when he asked her for bus fares home. He later changed his mind and wanted to go home to see his paus. I said that this was not the focus of the meetings. Spoke with dad about this evenings activities he is also struggling to cope with his behaviour at home. Meetings being held next week.

However Lewis taking control decided to cycle to Irvine.</p> <p>ple from mum at 4.50pm stating Lewis was there and wanted to stay the night and wanted me to re-organise the taxi arrangements. Harper he had been allegedly assaulted by [redacted] and was in a very upset state. He had visible lumps on both sides of his forehead and his eye was red and swollen. He also stated that he had been kicked in the ribs. Lewis stated that [redacted] had stolen his hat and when he asked for it back he was punched on the head. This happened in Linda Houston's class and ended in the school grounds with P. Harte, J. Harper witnessing Lewis being punched and kicked.</p> <p>DM informed and will contact police asking them to interview in the morning.</p> <p>plc to dad to inform of incident and how seriously we are dealing with it.</p>
19.5.99	<p>plc to police they will interview Lewis at home.</p> <p>Writer met with DM, P. Harte & North to discuss how to deal with this situation. [redacted] is very remorseful which staff say is also controlled. He was to be removed to an alternative class but there is no need as Lewis will not be in today. He did state he wanted to apologise this will have to be controlled by staff.</p>

 Plc to mum re incident she stated Lewis was well
 enough to play outside with his friends last night.

Very unsettled afternoon Lewis in and out classes like
 a go-go. brought him back to the unit to allow him
 the opportunity to share why he had been behaving so
 inappropriately. He would not speak at all apart from the
 odd grunt. He was behaving rather oddly, but the writer
 decided to keep him through the break where he chose
 to sit in silence. He did eventually mention that he had had
 a particularly difficult time in HE class and had
 created a mess and refused to clean it up. He was
 concerned about his money being docked as a result.
 It may be likely that there could be other possible
 issues for Lewis re: the forthcoming weekend he is
 spending with mum (the first in over 6 months).
 The assault by [redacted] and the subsequent
 resolution with [redacted] which resulted in them both remaining
 in the same class (charges being brought to [redacted] (assault))
 : being accused of snuffing gas/deceitful
 on Thurs 3:30pm - 5pm. spoke with Lewis [redacted]
 Lewis strongly denies this although no presenting
 behaviour would support it.

14/6/99 12pm	Lewis was involved in a scuffle with [redacted] and [redacted] considerable damage was done to the room in Education involving the burning of jotters. When the door was opened the bags were removed. Lewis was pleased to be let out. It would appear he was in the wrong place at the wrong time and did not want to be involved. He was interviewed by the police but not charged. Parents informed. Message left for Dad.
15/6/99	P/c from John to say Lewis had been reluctant to come in this morning in case there is a link back from yesterday's carry on. However, John spoke to him and he is on his way. Lewis had a good morning in Education, however reports of his behaviour from the sports day in the afternoon were quite negative. He had been involved with [redacted] in damaging materials & annoying others with pieces of metal from under the chairs. He was unco-operative in his response to the adults around in giving up the metal and behaving appropriately. David informed dad of these issues & suggested dad try to talk to Lewis tonight to explore any reasons for his recent lack of co-operation.
16/6/99	Lewis spoken to this morning with regards to yesterday's events at sports day and our concern about his recent slip in attitude & behaviour within education. He identified Aileen & John Paterson's class as difficulties but remained reluctant to take responsibility.
18/6/99	Following discussion above Lewis completed the week very positively with a huge improvement in class. Also attended and cycled with the group on Thursday.
