Thank you for your letter regarding this patient. She is appealing her application for Disability Living Allowance as she was turned down for this. I can confirm that Lisa does suffer from drug dependency. She has been established on Methadone from the DPC but is still using other prescription drugs and I suspect this will probably continue. I believe she does have significant problems with her motivation and having seen her recently she does not appear to be looking after herself very well. Because of her drug abuse she probable does experience symptoms of anxiety and panic and she did come across as being anxious in the surgery recently.

I am writing to you with regard to the above patient. We received a letter from yourself requesting information regarding her conditions and symptoms and we have also received a letter signed from Lisa saying she is happy for us to do this.

Looking through her past medical history of note on the computer, I see that it is documented that she was using drugs from around 1995 and again drug particular cannabis dependence is noted in 2000 and 2003. In 1999 she was felt to have depression this was again noted in 2003. Looking specifically through her notes she has been injecting and smoking heroin for a couple of years. She was been seen at the drug problem service a couple of years but missed her appointments with them. From what I can see in the notes she has continued to use heroin, however, has been assessed by the DPC yet again on the 7th April and she is due to be seen again in the near future with intent upon starting treatment. In terms of her low mood and depression, the last time this was mentioned specifically in her notes was in 2007. At this appointment she requested antidepressants and was given them, although has not been on them since. Looking further back into her notes, she was on antidepressants on and off in 2000 and 2003.

In terms of going out in the day or routine tasks, such as making a meal, I am afraid I am unable to comment as there is nothing in her notes with regard to this. Neither is there anything about anxiousness when she is in places she is unfamiliar with. I cannot say this is not the case it is just that we have not discussed this with her. At present she is on no regular medications, and as mentioned she is back in contact with the Drug Problem Service.
