Jordan had his Review Development Medical Examination today at Foxbar LAC Clinic. He was accompanied by care staff from Kibble Education and Care Centre.

He has made good progress in all areas of his development. His physical health has remained good. He is much happier and is in control of himself majority of the time, since he was commenced on Concerta XL 54 mgm daily. He is more focussed and attentive, his class progress is satisfactory. His medication is monitored by Donna Gillespie, CAMHS Specialist LAC Nurse.

His growth is good, his height and weight are on 75th centile. He does not have any side effects. He notices the effect of Concerta wearing off in the late evenings. He has no sleep problems. He has been discharged from the Podiatrist.

He is very happy because he is No.1 football player in the Kibble football team, also he was allowed unsupervised leave for 1 week to go to Inverness for holiday and he managed very well without getting into trouble. He is being allowed an other week during the Autumn break. He also has weekly contact with his mother.

He is refusing school leaving booster DTP Vaccine because of his phobia of needles. He will be counselled by Denise Carroll, LAC Specialist Nurse prior to him receiving his vaccination.

He will be reviewed in 12 months time.

The next assessment has been planned for October, 2007.
