REFLECTIVE ACCOUNT OF DISCUSSION AT KEYTIME SESSION

LEAVE PLAN WAS BEING DECIDED BY SOCIAL WORKER. ON A WEEK TO WEEK BASIS THE REASONS WHY HE HAD NO LEAVE LAST WEEKEND OR NO VISITS BY MUM TO SEE JORDAN. WRITER EXPLAINED IT AS SUCH. THAT HIS MUM HAD SPENT LAST WEEKEND IN JAIL AS A RESULT OF HER ATTEMPTING TO SMUGGLE DRUGS (HEROIN) INTO JAIL FOR ROBERT BY HIDING THE DRUGS IN HIS BABY SISTER'S NAPPY AND SHOES. JORDAN CLAIMED THAT HE WAS TOLD BY HIS SOCIAL WORKER THAT HE COULD NOT GO ON LEAVE BECAUSE THE FAMILY HOME WAS BEING PAINTED AND THAT HIS BROTHER'S AND SISTERS WERE STAYING AT PRAVINS. AGAIN I EXPLAINED THAT THIS WAS NOT THE CASE AND THAT I WOULD SPEAK TO HIS SOCIAL WORKER ABOUT THIS. WRITER THEN WENT ON TO EXPLAIN THAT UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE JORDAN COULD ONLY HAVE LEAVE TO MUMS IF THIS WAS SUPERVISED. HE WAS NOT HAPPY AND THIS BUT APPEARED TO UNDERSTAND.
