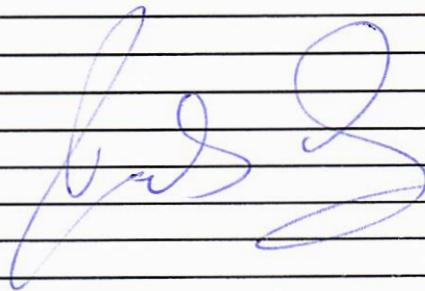

THAT THE REASON HE WAS LATE WAS BECAUSE HE WAS GOING FOR A FLY CIGARETTE. HE SMILED AND SAID HE COULD NOT HELP IT. WRITER TOLD JORDAN THAT HE WOULD GET HIM HELP TO STOP SMOKING. HOWEVER JORDAN DECLINED THIS OFFER. WE THEN SPOKE AT LENGTH RE THE CURRENT STATE OF S.C.M ASSIST'S JORDAN COULD NOT OR WOULD NOT GIVE ANY REASON FOR THIS EXCEPT FOR A STATEMENT HE MADE ABOUT BEING PISSED OFF ABOUT HIS LEAVE WRITER EXPLAINED THAT I WAS DOING ALL THAT WAS POSSIBLE TO SORT THIS OUT AND BE PATIENT. WRITER ALSO AGREED WITH JORDAN THAT WE WOULD ALTER HIS CURRENT LEAVE PLAN TO SEE IF THIS WOULD HELP. THIS LED ON TO A DISCUSSION ABOUT JORDAN'S CONSTANT USE OF ABUSIVE LANGUAGE WITH JORDAN AGREEING HE WOULD TRY TO STOP.
