You are at present receiving treatment under the Mental Health (Care and Treatment) (Scotland) Act 2003. The authority for your detention under a Compulsion Order has expired and was renewed for a further period of 12 months. This has been done because the doctor in charge of your treatment has decided that it is in your best interests for your treatment to be continued.

If you want the rules of your CO changed you, or your named person, have the right to appeal against the CO. You can only make an appeal after three months from the renewal date of the CO. To do this you must write to:
