Reveille routine as normal. All boys in workshops in the morning. Leave meetings in the afternoon in all houses with most boys being given extended leave till Tuesday due to Monday being the May-day holiday. A fairly quiet night in all houses but remains of fact that [redacted] Martin and [redacted] may try to abscond. Mr Wallace informed and asked to stay in N/H all night with Mr Warren checking M/House and W/House. A phone call from Garrow Police stating [redacted] in custody he was returned by the stand-by service. Otherwise a fairly pleasant nights duty.

As they were being told off news of [redacted] being assaulted etc (see code note.) Vin Lochaninnoch was received. Thereafter on hectic evening. All seems? Well at 11.40 pm. J.W.
