At this stage, the Council is unable to progress your request. Following an initial review, we were unable to identify any connection between the information you have requested and South Lanarkshire Council.

To allow us to conduct appropriate and proportionate searches—as required by the ICO’s guidance on handling Subject Access Requests—we need further information from you. In particular, please provide:

- Additional details about the individual concerned; and
- Their connection to the South Lanarkshire area or to South Lanarkshire Council services.

Until this clarification is received, your request is considered not valid, and the statutory one-month timescale for responding will not begin. Once we receive the required information, we will validate the request and commence the search.

Application to court

- take steps specified in the order or
- refrain from taking steps specified in the order.

You should take your own independent legal advice about going to court.
