CLINICAL HISTORY

Multiple grossly carious lower anterior teeth that have all been extracted. Periradicular lesion related to tooth 34 curetted. Separate large periradicular lesion involving teeth 32 through to 43 also curetted.

A - PERIAPICAL LESION RELATED TO TOOTH 34

Macro: The specimen consists of 13x7x7mm excision of centrally cystic soft tissue.

B - PERIAPICAL LESION RELATED TO TEETH 32 THROUGH TO 43

Macro: The specimen consists of two irregular soft tissue excisions, the larger measuring approximately 9x4mm and the smaller 2x2mm.

Micro (A+B): Histological examination of both specimens reveals benign cysts with a fibrotic wall and a lining that comprises non-keratinising, stratified squamous epithelium of variable thickness. There is a chronic inflammatory infiltrate of variable intensity within the cyst wall and a scattering of acute inflammatory cells.

Overall, in the appropriate clinical situation, the appearances are consistent with radicular cyst formation.

Thank you for referring the above patient who was seen on the 3rd September 2009 in the Oral Surgery treatment area.

Mr Egan presented complaining of broken teeth which caused him pain and he feels are traumatising the soft tissue of his upper edentulous ridge. He feels his remaining have been causing him problems for the last year.

His medical history is complicated in that he takes Citalopram and is also on Methadone 100mg daily. He has also admitted to continuing to smoke heroin. He smokes around 10 hand rolled tobacco cigarettes a day and drinks around 40 units of alcohol per week.

On examination his remaining teeth and retained roots are not TTP but do appear to be causing him a lot of discomfort especially the lower remaining teeth which are traumatising his upper gingivae.

Thank you for forwarding the disk of Mr Egan's OPT radiograph. The remaining teeth and retained roots seem to have no abnormal root anatomy and have some periapical lesions associated with some of the lower teeth. There also appears to be a buried root retained in the upper anterior region on the right hand side.

On discussion with the patient it was decided that a full mouth clearance the best treatment option and I have arranged for this to be carried out under IV sedation on 20th November 2009. Due to Mr Egan's generous alcohol intake we carried out a full blood count and coagulation screen which we will check before proceeding with the treatment.

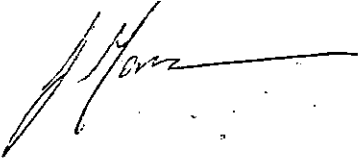

I have also warned Mr Egan that due to his prolonged use of Methadone he may be more resistant to the effects of the sedative agent that we use.

Micro (A+B): Histological examination of both specimens reveals benign cysts with a fibrotic wall and a lining that comprises non-keratinising, stratified squamous epithelium of variable thickness. There is a chronic inflammatory infiltrate of variable intensity within the cyst wall and a scattering of acute inflammatory cells.

Overall, in the appropriate clinical situation, the appearances are consistent with radicular cyst formation.
