Thank you for seeing in your out patients department this 29 year old gentleman with the following problems.

1. Known Hepatitis C positive with PCR positive
2. Elevated LFT's June 1998 - AST 221, ALT 662.
3. Hep A and Hep B negative
4. Previous opiate abuse IV with a three month reducing course of methadone in 1997
5. Recently moved to Sheffield from HMP Glenochil under the care of a Dr. P. Bramley at Stirling Royal Infirmary unit no. 144397

Denys attended our surgery after moving to Norfolk Park from Scotland. He was requesting referral to the liver clinic after he was advised by the doctors looking after him in prison. He has never had a liver biopsy or interferon treatment for his Hepatitis C which I presume has been known about since June 1998. It was reported that he may have had an active EBV infection which gave him his deranged LFT's and the finding of Hep C was incidental to this.

He is not currently taking any medication and is not using opiates at present. he has no known allergies. Previous medication has been paroxetine and propranolol in prison to help with his anxiety and panic attacks.

On examination he appears pale and sallow, no evidence of jaundice, no clubbing or lymphadenopathy, chest is clear, abdomen is soft non tender with a palpable smooth liver edge. BP 110/60.

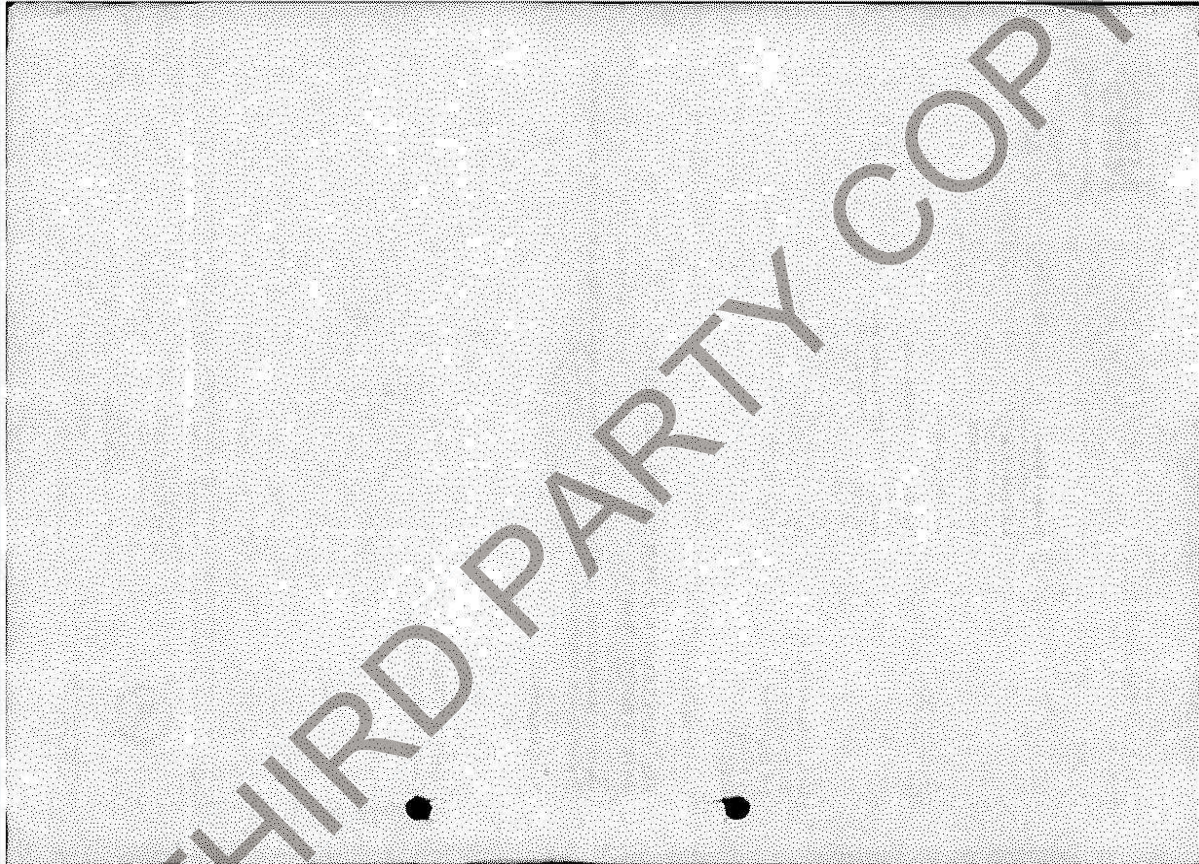

I saw Denys on 30<sup>th</sup> July 2002 at the Bentinck Centre, Kilmarnock, regarding his drug addiction problems and anxiety symptoms. He is currently prescribed:- Methadone 80mls daily supervised; Diazepam 5 x 10mgs daily.

He attends the Townhead Centre but apparently not on a regular basis. He told me that he buys 20 - 30mg extra Diazepam most days, smokes some cannabis (although had a three month period of abstinence earlier this year) and has stopped Heroin altogether for several weeks.

His main preoccupations surround his divorce and various family tensions. He talked about ongoing sleep problems and flashbacks to his previous trauma, but only when prompted. He feels he is progressing well and certainly having custody of his son reflects this.

I have agreed to hold his Diazepam at 50mgs daily and his Methadone at 80mls. I will review him in October/November.
