I saw Denys for review at the Caley Court clinic on the 13 November 2012. There seemed to be some confusion over his appointment, in that he had an appointment last Tuesday and didn't attend this. I wasn't clear from what Denys told me about the appointment, as to why this was the case. He did suggest that he had discussed this with his CAT counsellor.

Denys is doing extremely well on his current script, having not used on top of it for some time. He tells he has lost 9 stone in weight over the past year or so, at the instructions of Dr Allen with a view to starting Hepatitis C treatment. Apparently this is going to be 44 weeks long, therefore we will not make any adjustments in his medication over that period of time.

I note he continues on Gabapentin, Mirtazapine and Movicol and seems to be having no problems. In fact his weight loss has improved his Sciatica, he tells me. He continues to be reviewed by his CAT counsellor and due to the fact he is going on Hep C treatment, I will not arrange a further review appointment for him for a year.

Mr Brown attended Dr Allen's Out Patient Clinic this afternoon. He has a diagnosis of Hepatitis C Genotype I. He has normal liver function tests and alpha-fetoprotein. He does not drink and has never drunk alcohol, although he does continue to smoke. He is currently taking Methadone, Diazepam and Gabapentin.

He is keen to start treatment. However there are various issues preventing this at the moment. Firstly he has a raised BMI of 34 and we would not treat unless this was less than 30. He is also well known to psychiatrists at the Addiction Services and has a CPN, Samantha Jamieson to deal with his anxiety and paranoia issues. He describes his mood as "not bad" at the moment.

I will be reluctant to start treatment on this gentleman unless we have permission from the psychiatrist's point of view. Today we will refer him to a dietician to help him continue his weight loss effort.

We will see him back in clinic with the results of the CPN report and after he has seen the dietician. We will also check today his Hep B status because he says he has been vaccinated during his time in prison.

I saw Denys for review at the Townhead Centre on the 21 June 2011. Denys has been stable for months having not used for some considerable time. He is currently on 110mls of Methadone daily supervised and 30mgs of Diazepam. He apparently had urinalysis performed yesterday but was positive for Opiates as he was given a Cocodamol from his father at the weekend.

Denys' main problem is his paranoia which has led him to use illicit Seroquel which has calmed him down. He initially said that his paranoia and his inability to go out was due to a previous assault with metal bars some two to three years ago. He also has a past history of physical abuse by his father when he was a child. However apparently also there was an incident aged 8 when he was out with his step cousin who was aged 6 who ran out in front of a car before Denys could pull him back. Denys was actually hit by the car at a glancing blow but unfortunately his cousin was killed. He was unable to admit to this at the time and first revealed it to another person aged 18. Apparently he has mentioned this to Dr Stirling and Dr Flowerdew whom he saw in prison.

**Change of Medication**

As a practice we are dedicated to providing the best possible care for all of our patients and to this end we undertake a continuous review of the medicines we prescribe in light of new evidence or indeed changes in price. NHS Ayrshire & Arran has a limited budget for medicines and it is important that value for money is achieved in order that we can continue to prescribe new and expensive medicines. It also means that any savings in prescribing budgets can be channeled in to other patient services. NHS Ayrshire & Arran have asked all practices to consider our use of certain treatments in order to try to make the budget for medicines go further, and we need to participate in the process.

We note from our records that you have on your repeat prescription a medicine called **Movicol sachets**, which is used to treat symptoms of constipation. Therefore, to ensure we make best use of our funds, all of the doctors in the practice have decided to ask you to change your prescription and we would like you to try a different form of the medicine, changing to a new product called **Laxido sachets**. These new sachets are available in an orange flavour and will work in exactly the same way as your current sachets to treat symptoms and we are confident you won't notice any difference from this change.

**If you are happy to change over you do not need to take any action at present.** You should finish any of your **Movicol sachets** that you still have, using them in your normal way. You do not need to contact the surgery until your next prescription is due when you will find **Laxido sachets** has been added to your list of repeat medicines in place.

If you are not happy to change over, please tell us by completing and sending back the tear-off slip below and return it to the surgery by 3<sup>rd</sup> August 2012. In this case we will not change your medicine at this time. Please note we do not wish to cause any problems for you with the above switch. In the unlikely event you feel unhappy with the new product, please let us know.

If you have any queries our Prescribing Support Pharmacist: Louise Purvis is in the practice on Wednesdays and Fridays to answer your calls and can be contacted by telephoning the surgery number and holding for general enquiries. Or alternatively you can ask your Doctor at your next routine appointment or Community Pharmacist.
