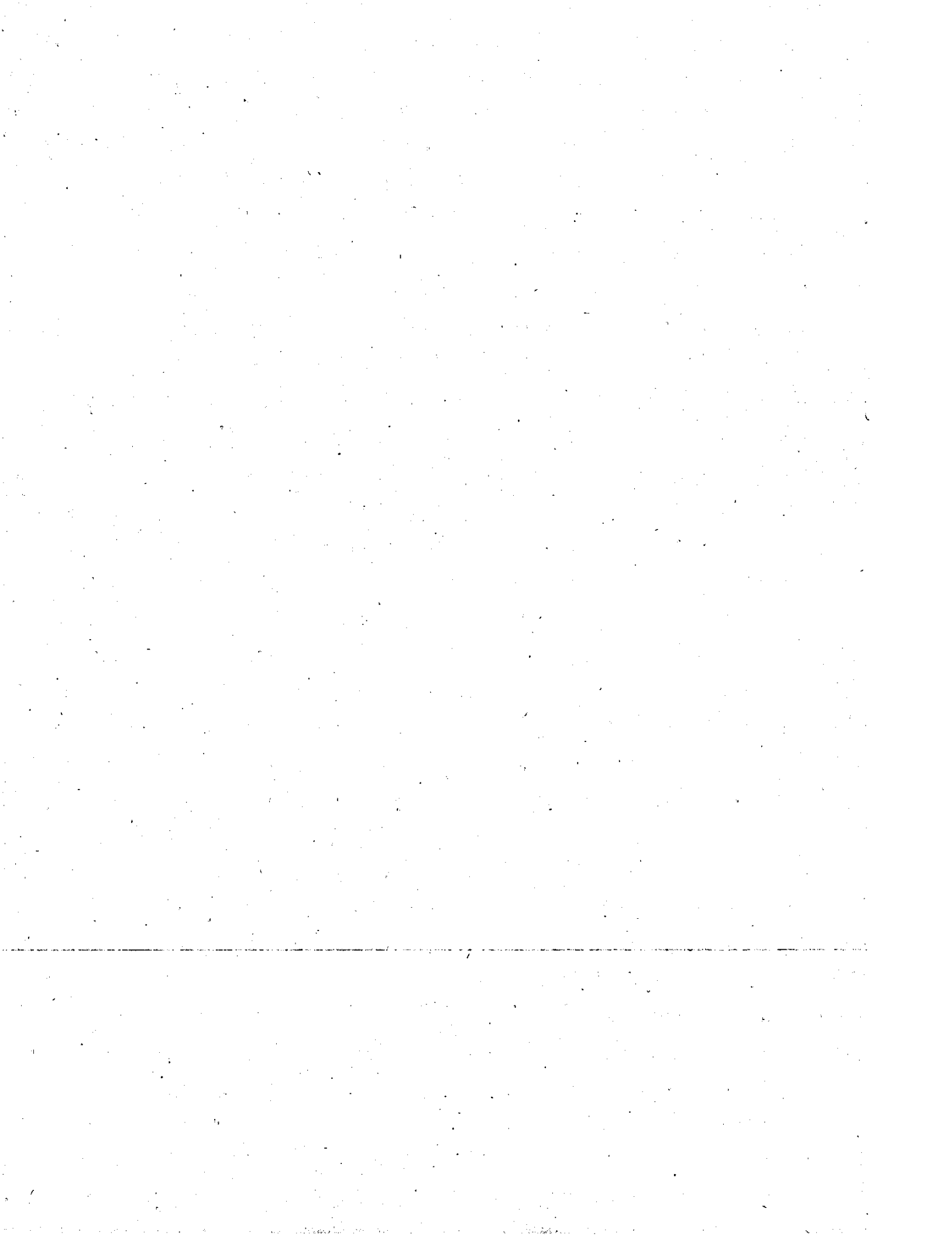

Clinical Comments:

Diagnosis: Osteoarthritis of the left middle finger PIP joint.

Outcome: Patient initiated review.

Many thanks for referring the above gentleman to the orthopaedic clinic. Malcolm attended today and reports that he has issues on and off with his left middle finger, specifically more around the PIP joint. He had an x-ray of this and it does show osteoarthritic changes around the joint. He feels it's swollen, it can be painful from time to time and he has a reduced grip as a result of this. He denies any pins and needles or numbness. He reports that the cold weather is more problematic and sometimes gripping the steering wheel as a van driver can be problematic, and doing the clips on the van.

He's a Type 2 diabetic and suffers from high blood pressure. He lives with his wife and is a lorry driver.

On assessment today there is no colour changes, no swelling and no wastage noted. He did have early onset of Dupuytren's disease on the palm of the hand and he was fully aware of this. His PIP joint of the left middle finger did have reduced movement and was painful at the end of range,

but in all he was able to make a fist today. All other joints were fully mobile and had a full range of movement.

Malcolm is aware that he has osteoarthritis. He's aware that there's no cure for this and we offered him the option of conservative treatment of physiotherapy or steroid injection. Given the fact that he's currently in a good condition and not too problematic, we decided to leave the steroid injection until he was in a positive flare. I've therefore given him the secretary's number and at times where his finger was to flare up I'd be more than happy to see him back in clinic to inject his finger. With regards to the physiotherapy, he feels that with his job he is constantly using his hands and he doesn't need any further strengthening or range of movement exercises, therefore, he has politely declined this.

We will review him in the future if his finger was to flare up.

Comment: This 62 year old HGV driver is having increasing problems with the fingers of both hands. He describes constant pain in fingers despite co-codamol and dihydrocodeine. This pain is constant but he also describes shooting pains in fingers without warning for example when holding steering wheel or trying to lift shopping bags. The pain is now affecting his daily life at home and work. Please find enclosed hand xrays no erosions but showing degeneration. Previous rheumatoid factor negative and inflammatory markers normal (I am updating bloods) no erosions on xrays. No other significant joint pains. I would appreciate your assessment regarding treatment options other than long term escalation of analgesia.

Description: Hand and shoulder pain

Comment: Dear Team

This 60 year old gentleman has difficulties with pain in his hands and shoulders.

The pain in his hands falls into two distinctive syndromes. Firstly he has pain that appears in keeping with osteoarthritis and x-rays have confirmed this. This is associated with some weakness of the intrinsic musculature of his hands which he worries about as it is beginning to affect his abilities to perform manual task relating to his job as a an HGV driver. Secondly he describes neuralgic pain which occurs intermittently whilst holding a steering wheel for a long periods.

I would be grateful if you could go through hand muscular strengthening exercises with Mr MacGregor. I have suggested to him that he seeks occupational health assessment via his employer in regards to the neuralgic pain which is extremely positional and is occurring only when he is holding a steering wheel.

Secondly his shoulder pain has been present for several months. This is bilateral and worse on the right shoulder. The pain is worse on movement and particularly bad at night. Examination demonstrates full range of movement but pain in the mid rack. Xrays have demonstrated mild OA . I would be very grateful if you could assess his shoulders also.

Given the complexities here I thought it best for me to write this referral rather than asking Mr MacGregor to self refer. I have no doubt however that he will be capable of engaging with your opt in system.
