### You qualify for Adult Disability Payment

You qualify for Adult Disability Payment from 29 January 2026. This letter and decision report is your notice of determination. It tells you about our decision and why we made it.

| When we'll pay you               | How much we'll pay you |
|----------------------------------|------------------------|
| First payment on 8 July 2026     | £1,660.60              |
| Then every 4 weeks on a Thursday | £306.80                |

We'll pay you using the bank details you gave us. Your regular payment will always be for the last 4 week period. If your normal payment day is a bank holiday, we'll pay you the working day before.

Your first payment is different. It's backdated to when you became eligible and covers from 29 January 2026 to 1 July 2026.

### We'll review our decision on 1 July 2028

We based our decision on your current needs. We'll review this again on 1 July 2028. We'll be in touch about a month before your review to let you know what to do.

### Tell us if you disagree with our decision

If you do not agree with our decision, you have the right to ask us to take another look at your application. This is called a re-determination. It is where a new team who were not involved in making our original decision will look at your application again, along with any new information you want to give us. This new decision could mean your payment goes up, down or stays the same.
